Job Descriptions:

The **Server** position is the most difficult position that we offer to Work and Travel participants, but it offers the greatest rewards. As a server you take food and drink orders, serve food and drink to the guests, and collect payment. Servers must be comfortable working on their feet for long shifts, capable of multi tasking and maintaining a positive attitude. The **wage is \$3.63/hour + tips**. There are **8 positions available**.

As a **Host** you will be the face of our restaurant and the first person that our guests see when they come in the front door. Hosts will greet guests and seat them at their tables. The host position may also include a shift or two a week working in our retail shop selling Dead Freddie's merchandise to guests. Hosts must always possess a positive attitude, the ability to work as a team to achieve maximum guest satisfaction, and be able to work on their feet for long shifts. The **wage is \$9.25/hour**. There are **8 positions available**.

As a **Bar Back/Busser** you will be responsible for maintaining the cleanliness of the restaurant, stocking the restaurant, and cleaning up after the guests. The bar back position requires heavy lifting, teamwork, and the ability to work long shifts on your feet. The **wage is \$3.63/hour + tips**. There are **5 positions available**.

Work Hours: You should expect to work about **30 hours/week** on average throughout the summer. Since we seat customers outdoors, a lot of our business is weather dependent and your hours could be shortened if it is raining or not nice outside. Hours and shifts will be determined based on performance and availability. Students who do the best job will be given the best shifts.

Work Start Dates: You should plan your US arrival so you can begin working as early as **May 15**.

Work Finish Dates: We are looking for candidates who can stay as late as possible. The latest you can finish working is **September 15**. You must give at least two weeks notice of your final day of work and we ask that you are as upfront and honest as possible about your work finish date.

Uniform: All employees wear a plain black t-shirt (2 staff shirts are provided upon completion of training). Men wear tan khaki shorts and women wear black shorts. All must wear black non-slip athletic shoes.

Housing Information: We do not provide housing for J-1 participants, but we are able to assist you by answering any questions you have, pointing you in the right direction, and referring you to the local student outreach programs in the area that help J-1 students with housing.

Area Description: You will have the opportunity to schedule your own cultural activities during your program. Ocean City offers a multitude of fun activities such as the Ocean City Airshow, 4th of July Celebrations, and Summer Concerts. Every year our students take weekend trips to Washington D.C., Philadelphia, Baltimore, and New York City all of which are within 4 hours driving distance from Ocean City.
