Employer Description:

The first Bubba Gump Shrimp Co. restaurant and market opened in 1996 on Cannery Row in Monterey, California. We've since grown to include many notable locations throughout the United States and internationally. At the core, we're a small chain of seafood restaurants committed to providing a casual environment where everyone can enjoy a great meal and have some fun, too. Food is the hero at the Bubba Gump Shrimp Co.; we serve food that makes our employees. Located on the Navy Pier, our Chicago restaurant is especially picturesque with grand views of the city and Lake Michigan. There are many attractions on Navy Pier such as parks, gardens, shops, & restaurants.





Position Descriptions: All employees, regardless of position, are required by the state of Illinois to complete and turn in an Illinois Food Handler certification within 30 days of beginning work. You can start getting paid as soon as you provide us with a copy of your **Social Security application receipt**.

Hosts/hostesses are responsible for helping guests, seating patrons, cleaning tables, sweeping the floors, and keeping the host station clean. You should be prepared to help out where needed and in general help keep the restaurant clean and running smoothly. There are **5 positions available**. The wage is \$10.00/hour + tips.

Bus Persons/Food Runners are responsible for helping guests, sweeping floors, cleaning tables, running food. You should also be prepared to help out where needed and in general help keep the restaurant clean and running smoothly. There are approximately **5 positions available**. The **wage is \$9.00/hour + tips.**

Retail Sales Associates are responsible for interacting with guests in an effort to provide them with a high quality shopping experience at our in-restaurant store. You will be handling US currency, reaching sales goals and attending to non-sales related duties (i.e. cleaning, merchandising, inventory management). There are approximately **5 positions available**. The wage is \$12.00/hour.

Servers are responsible for waiting on guests, answering questions, making menu recommendations, delivering food & drinks, and rolling silverware. You will work in a team environment, which includes completing any additional side work. You should also be comfortable dealing with US currency. Chicago law states that you **must be at least 21 years old** to work as a server. All servers MUST complete an online Food Handler class as well as an online class for Responsible Alcohol Service that is required from the state of IL. There are approximately **20 positions available**. The **wage is \$6.25/hour + tips**.

Work Hours: Over the summer you should expect to have an average of **30 hours per week** with June usually being a slower month. Because we have outdoor seating your hours could be affected by the weather. Additionally if your performance is below our standards then your hours could be decreased.

Uniform: All employees are required to provide themselves with slip resistant shoes and pants/shorts that are approved for their uniform. We provide discount coupons for the non slip shoes at local stores.

Work Start Dates: You should plan your arrival so you can begin work May 15 - June 1. The earlier the better.

Work Finish Dates: We are looking to hire candidates who can finish working **August 25 - September 15.** The later you can stay the better. Employees are required to give at least two weeks notice of their final work date.

Housing Information: We do not provide housing for J-1 students, but we can point you in the right direction. Students in past years have stayed in buildings on 777 State Street, which is set up for J-1 Visa students. They have also found apartments for sublet on Craigslist.com.
