# Job Description:

**Team Members** start early (5:00 AM is common). We wear jeans. You'll make the best sandwiches (with amazing, natural ingredients). You'll be part of a great team. And we bet you'll have fun too.

A Pret Team Member works in the kitchen and front of house with their Pret team. They follow the 4 core Pret behaviors in all aspect of their work: Passion, Clear Communication, Great Execution & Team Working. They are responsible for creating a welcome and safe environment, engaging and "wowing" our customers and producing great quality Pret food. Key focuses for the role are teamwork, uniforms, the '6 Key Points of Service and Production', cleanliness, health & safety, and productivity.

Work Hours: You should expect to work about **30 - 35 hours/week** on average throughout the summer. You will receive a weekly schedule 2 weeks in advance.





**Work Start Dates:** Pret will host two work begin dates. You can either start work on **June 3** or **June 10**. On these days we will host orientations, begin training, and there will be a welcome party. Pret and InterExchange suggest that you arrive to the U.S. at least a few days before your work start date so you can sort out housing, Social Security, and get a chance to familiarize yourself with the city.

**Work End Date:** We are looking for candidates who can stay until **September 15th**. We require that you give at least two weeks notice of your final day of work.

**Uniform:** Team Members are responsible for purchasing navy blue jeans, black non slip (polishable) shoes, and black socks. Pret will provide you with the shirts, hats, and belts.

Additional requirements:

- Clean shaven
- Minimal makeup
- Great personal hygiene
- Clean short nails no acrylics or nail polish
- No jewelry (except a plain wedding band)
- All tattoos must be covered
- No eyelash extensions

**Interview Format:** We are able to hire friend groups, but not couples. We will be conducting our interviews individually.

**Housing Information:** Pret A Manger does not provide housing for J-1 participants, but we can point you in the right direction. We recommend speaking with friends who have done a J-1 in the past for housing advice. Make sure you have a signed lease clearly stating your agreement, the rules & regulations, & security deposit.

### Area Descriptions:
